What is it?

The Chair of Digital Innovation and the Public Sector (DIPS) is an ERCIS research group at WWU Münster whose research focuses on digitalization phenomena at the interface between the public sector, the private sector and society. As a link between ERCIS and the REACH start-up center at WWU, the topics of digital innovation and intra/entrepreneurship are particularly focused on in this context.

Who are we looking for?

We are looking for motivated candidates with the following profile:

- You are at least in your second semester and can manage your studies well in terms of time and subject matter.
- Very good English language skills
- You should be able and willing to work independently.
- Ideally, you already have practical experience in the development of Learnweb modules.
- > Beginner knowledge in PHP, JavaScript and/or HTML5 is also desirable.

The main focus of your work will be to support the research group in teaching and research activities. This can be, for example, the support in the preparation of courses such as lectures or project seminars.

An important part of your tasks is the design, development, and maintenance of Learnweb modules for the courses. This includes regular exchange with the academic staff to iteratively develop the Moodle content.

Prospectively, there are also further opportunities to contribute to the research group and to collaborate with students, government agencies, start-ups, and established companies from the private sector.

The position is limited to 6 months only, an extension is planned. WWU Münster is committed to gender equity and aims to increase the proportion of women in research and teaching. Applications from women are therefore explicitly welcome; women will be given preferential consideration in cases of equal suitability, ability, and professional performance, unless reasons relating to the person of a competitor prevail. Severely disabled persons with the same qualifications will be given preference.
