





The European Research Center for Information Systems (ERCIS) is looking for a student assistant (6-10 h/week)

The chair of information systems and information management (Professor Becker) is from now on looking for a student assistant (6-10h/week) for support in a joint research project with SAP concerned with blockchain technology.

What do we do?

A new research project will demonstrate the use of blockchain technology in royalty management. Royalty management includes the management of fees resulting from intellectual property. Since SAP sells, purchases and uses software (= intellectual property) in its products, a complex network is created. This network is an ideal application of the blockchain, because decentralized trust between the actors has to be established.

The project will begin in April 2019 and is expected to be completed by the end of the semester.

Who are we looking for?

We are looking for motivated applicants who would like to get involved as soon as possible (for one semester):

- You are at least in your third semester of your bachelor degree and handle your studies well.
- You are interested in the field of Blockchain and ideally have some experience.
- You are experienced in using the MS Office Suite and especially PowerPoint.
- You like working in teams.
- You work precisely and have a high ability to concentrate.

- You don't find it difficult to dig into new topics.
- You are spontaneous and ready to actively support a new research project in the coming semester (summer term 2019).

Working hours can be handled flexibly and do not have to be provided at the institute. Of course, we take examination phases into consideration. The project can easily result in your final thesis topic.

The positions are limited to 6 months. WWU Münster advocates gender equality and strives to increase the proportion of women in research and teaching. In the case of equal suitability, ability and professional achievement, female candidates will be given preference, provided that the personal qualities of another candidate are not more appropriate for the position. Disabled persons with the same qualifications are hired preferentially.

What are your tasks?

- Research activities (e.g. market analysis)
- Conceptual Modeling
- Frontend configuration of the SAP blockchain service
- Project management support
- Preparation of meetings
- Documentation of project progress
