What to expect from a ...

- Seminar (6 CP, 18oh workload):
 - Elaborating a scientific topic, learn scientific working
 - Presentation of acquired knowledge and results
- Project Seminar (12 CP, 360 h workload):
 - Current research topic, often industry cooperation
 - Research as well as modeling and implementing information systems
 - Collaborating in a team









Selected/Special Chapters ...



- Elective lecture on a very specific topic
- Not necessarily related to IS tracks or BA and CS
- Standard structure:
 - 2 hours of lecture / week
 - 2 hours of tutorial / week
 - Up to 120 min exam
 - 6 CP
- No capacity limits → no application (just go there, but register also for exam)





Application

- Web-"Application":
 - Seminar Application Frontend via the Institute's web page (www.wi.uni-muenster.de)
 - Log in (left column) with your ZIV account
 - Start seminar management tool.
 - Apply to the seminars / project seminars you like.
- Priorities:
 - for one seminar state at least 3 priorities
 - for more than one seminar state at least 5 priorities
- Too few priorities may lead to a (central) disqualification such that no seminar can be assigned.





The Students' Frontend

- Overview of available Seminars and Project Seminars
- You are guided through the application process
 - Personal data
 (address, matriculation number, etc.)
 - 2) Selection/combination of Seminars and Project Seminars (e.g. number of Seminar and PS, Seminar xor PS, ...)
 - 3) Priorities (select seminars according to personal preferences)
 - Motivation/CVs
 (you may/have to add a motivation letter of CV for specific seminars)
 - 5) Review: Final overview before submission (you may edit or delete your submission until deadline)





Application Deadline and further Dates

- Seminar application starts today (25.06.2015)
- Open until o5.07.2015, 11:59 pm
- Afterwards: Assignment according to priorities and capacities
- Publication of final assignments (about)
 13.07.2015
