



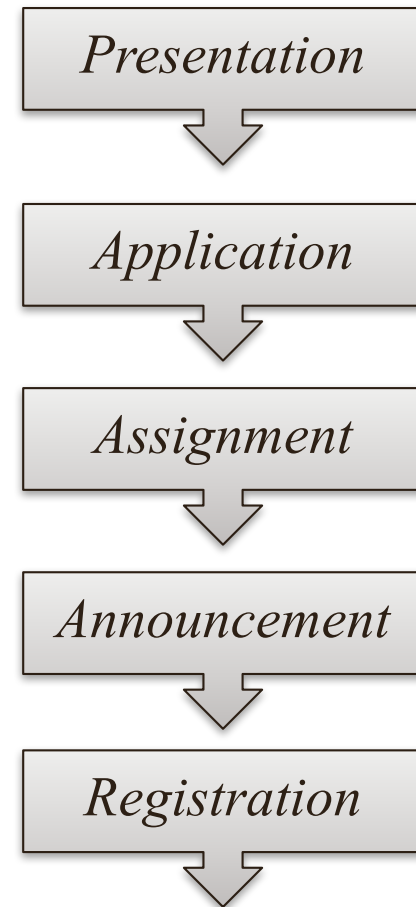

## What to expect of a ...

- **Project Seminar**

- 12 Credit Points, 360h workload
- Current research topic, often industry cooperation
- Involves a broad range of activities
  - Project organization
  - Research
  - Modeling
  - Implementing
- Team Work !

**Keep in mind:**

You can only take one project seminar during your studies!

Application needed.

Registration with examination office needed (beginning of April).

## What to expect of a ...

### • Seminar

- 6 Credit Points, 180h workload
- Work on a selected topic from Information Systems Research.
- Learn how to critically evaluate academic research.
- Extend your skills in academic writing and working.

#### **Keep in mind:**

You need to take two seminars during your studies!

Application needed (now).

### • Selected Chapter

- Elective lecture on a very specific topic
- Not necessarily directly related to IS tracks, BA, and CS
- Standard structure:
  - 2 hours of lecture / week
  - 2 hours of tutorial / week
  - Up to 120 min exam; 6 Credit Points

Registration with examination office needed (beginning of April).

## How to apply...

- Application via: <https://www.wi.uni-muenster.de/de/user/login>
  - Log in (page footer) with your ZIV-account
  - Start seminar management tool
  - Apply to the seminars / project seminars
- 
- Priorities
    - For one (project) seminar state at least 3 priorities.
    - For more than one seminar state at least 5 priorities.
  - Too few priorities may lead to a (central) disqualification.

## The Application Process

- Overview of available Seminars and Project Seminars
- You are guided through the application process
  - Personal data  
(address, matriculation number, etc.)
  - Selection/combination of Seminars and Project Seminars  
(e.g. number of Seminar and PS, Seminar xor PS, ...)
  - Priorities  
(select seminars according to personal preferences)
  - Motivation/CVs  
(you may/have to add a motivation letter of CV for specific seminars)
  - Review: Final overview before submission  
(you may edit or delete your submission until deadline)
